# Year 3 Soil Exploration





Year 3 had a great time exploring soil, compost and the job of worms!



# Healthspace Cook Out



## TOMATO, LENTIL AND VEGETABLE SOUP RECIPE

Did you like your soup at this week's Cook Out? Here's the recipe!

### **INGREDIENTS**

- Low-calorie cooking spray
- 1 Onion, peeled and finely chopped
- 2 Garlic cloves, peeled and crushed
- 2cm Piece root ginger, peeled and finely grated
- 2 Celery sticks, finely chopped
- 1 Large potato, peeled and cut into 1.5cm dice
- 1 Large carrot, peeled and cut into 1.5cm dice
- 600ml Boiling hot vegetable stock
- 1 tbsp Mild curry powder
- 125g Dried red lentils, rinsed and drained
- 600ml Passata
- A handful of chopped fresh coriander, to garnish

### **METHOD**

Spray a large saucepan with low calorie cooking spray and place over a high heat. Add the onion, garlic, ginger, celery, potato and carrot and stir-fry for 1-2 minutes.

Add the remaining ingredients and bring to the boil. Cover and simmer gently for 15-20 minutes or until the lentils are cooked. Season well and serve sprinkled with coriander.

*"You can read the recipe to get an idea of what you need to do, then add or swap any ingredients you want. This week we swapped celery for grated sweet potato"*
