Our chosen phonics programme, Book Wings, is based on exciting, engaging books from the best children's authors. Each new sound (phoneme) and letter pattern (grapheme) that matches it has its own real book on which to base learning. However, we do understand that children need to practise reading books that match the letters and sounds they know. To support children learning to read, we are very pleased to announce the launch of Bug Club Online. Children in Reception, Years 1 and 2, who are using phonics to read words, will have their own username and password to access specially chosen books at the right level for them. 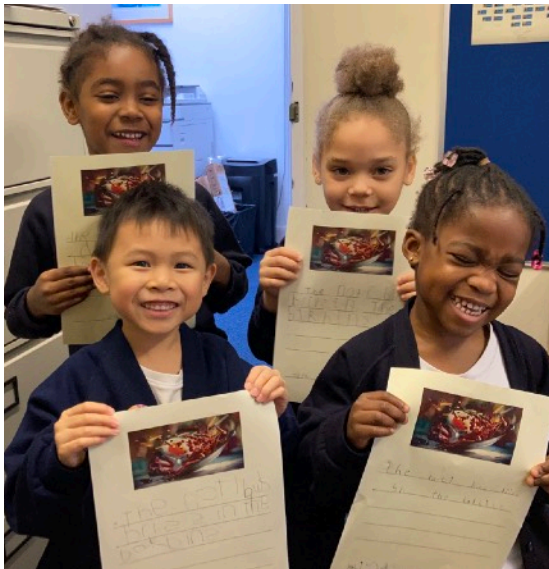
### Healthspace Weigh & Measure Programme
