



## Y1 Dinosaur Museum at OAJ!

Year 1 may not have managed to go to the Natural History Museum as a class, however they had a great time showing their families around the OAJ Dinosaur Museum yesterday afternoon. It began with a rousing, roaring dino song, complete with actions. Then budding archeologists carefully dug up bones from the sand and then tried to free the dinosaurs stuck in their frozen eggs! Thankfully all were rescued. Children showed off their learning from this term, including an exhibition of all their homework and sharing dinosaur books they have enjoyed reading. Everyone was treated to some real fossils brought in by Laszlo and his Mum Emma, revealing how carefully they could handle artefacts as they passed them round. Finally, they showed off all their dinosaur knowledge in a live quiz. Children confidently talked about many things including carnivores, omnivores, invertebrates and vertebrates. What great learning this term Year 1.

We will also show the kind of work that children need to complete in Years 5 and 6 where they will use this multiplication/division knowledge alongside giving ideas/strategies for you to use at home to help them consolidate their learning. We will then update you if there are any significant changes when we get the further guidance in March.

I hope you all have a restful, relaxing and rejuvenating half term holiday and come back prepared for the next half year of exciting learning. Remember, school reopens Monday 21st February at 8.55am and that we are not allowed to authorise term-time holidays.

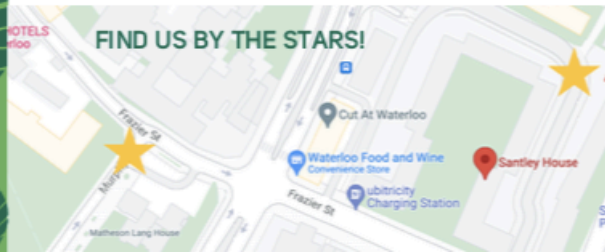
