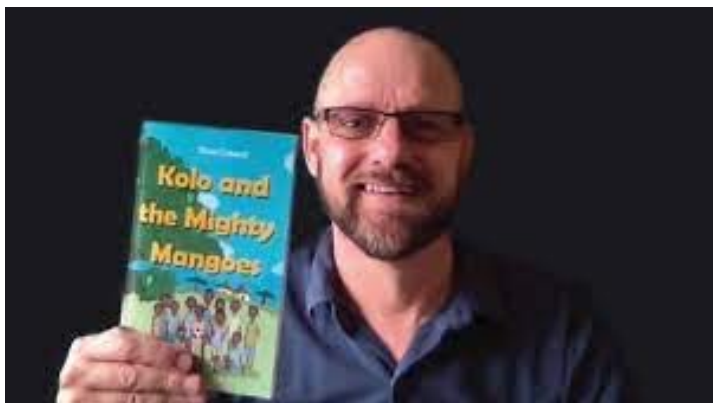


Save the date: 12th May

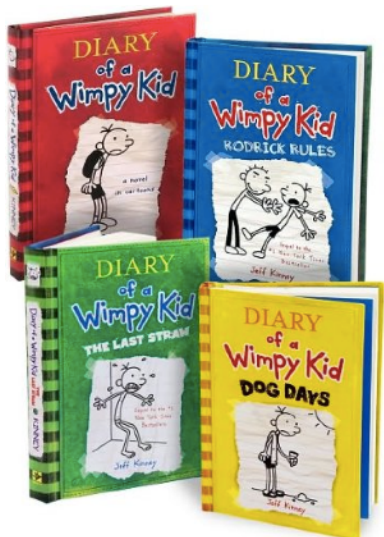
Are you a 'Wimpy Kid' Fan?
