## **Contacting School**

Thank you all for your patience and forebearance whilst BT fixed the phone line problem. This makes us realise how important it is to use the <a href="mailto:info@oasisjohanna.org">info@oasisjohanna.org</a> email address when you cannot get through on the telephone or is less urgent.

There are several members of staff who look at this email, and we endeavour to respond to all info@ emails from parents/carers within one hour during working time 9am to 3pm.

Emails sent directly to staff will hopefully be answered within 24 hours, though this cannot be guaranteed - especially by teachers and teaching assistants who spend all day with children teaching.

### **Attendance**

The Government expects all children to be in school at least 96% of the time. We are really pleased that the vast majority of our children come to school well above this figure. There are rewards for



great attendance each term and for those children who really improve.

We are working with the Lambeth Education Welfare Services to ensure that all absences from school are genuine, evidenced and therefore can be authorised.

#### Telephone EVERY DAY your child is ill

Parents/Carers must telephone **by 9am every day** that their child is ill, to confirm that their child is still off and confirm the reason for this continued absence.

If you do not telephone by 9am, we will telephone you. If there is no answer when we ring, we may need to make a home visit. Please do call us first.

#### **Medical/Dental Appointments**

Where possible, these should be made AFTER SCHOOL or IN HOLIDAYs. These include routine dentist appointments (you need to book early!)

We understand there are some medical appointments that need to happen in school time, e.g. consultant appointments. Parents/Carers need to bring proof of the appointment to the school office or we cannot authorise the absence. Evidence can be an appointment card, letter, email or text from medical professional. **No Evidence = No Authorisation** 

## What happens if my child's attendance falls below 96%?

If your child's attendance falls below 96%, you will need to have medical evidence from a doctor. All further illness absences will be unauthorised without this evidence. Parents/Carers will need to meet with our Attendance Lead Paul and then the child's attendance will be monitored weekly to ensure improvement.

## What happens if my child's attendance falls below 90%?

At this point, children will have missed the equivalent of a day a week of learning. Parents/Carers will be called to meet the Principal and an action plan will be written to improve attendance. There is a risk of court action if there is not immediate, significant and sustained improvement in attendance.


#### What about COVID?

All covid-related absences are not counted in our attendance figures.

## What if my child has a serious medical condition or SEND?

We will look at every child as an individual. It is heartbreaking when children have a serious illness and we will do all we can to support the child and the family in this difficult time.

Children who have long-term medical or special educational needs may need more time off for appointments or suffer from illness more readily. In these cases, we will have medical evidence from the consultant or team (such as occupational health, physiotherapy) and we will work with you to minimise the disruption to your child's attendance and learning.



### Punctuality - 8.55am

Our school starts at 8.55am and the gates close at 9.00am. Most of our children do arrive within this 5 minute window. During COVID, we were able to give more time for arriving and dismissing children. However, there are no regulations now in force so we have to return to normal practice.

FROM MONDAY - we will open the Year 1/2/3/4 gate at 8.50am and allow all CHILDREN to wait outside their classroom door. The Y5/6 gate will open at 8.55am as normal.

At 9am, the gates will close. If your child is late, you need to bring them to the Y5/6 gate and explain the reason for lateness. If your child is regularly late, you will need to meet with our Attendance Officer Cara. If lateness continues you will need to meet with our Attendance Lead Paul. If lateness becomes a persistent problem, you will need to meet with our Principal.
