### Year 6

### Year 3 Teacher

### Attendance compulsory till 20/7/22

We have had 9 requests so far for children to take absences before the end of term. We are NOT allowed to authorise any. I do understand if you have ill relatives that you wish to visit abroad, however you do need to wait until the school holidays begin.

All children who have missed the final week or so of school, **without medical evidence of illness**, will be referred for a fine. If your child is ill and misses the last day of term, you will need to visit your GP asking for medical evidence of illness otherwise you will be referred for a fine. GPs are not always willing to do this, however we can refer them to the relevant government guidance that compels them to provide this. Please do not make it hard for staff in school who have to refer you for a fine.

## Hot Weather

We are committed to ensuring children get the best education and do not miss any more school, they have missed enough over the past 2 and a half years. We also want to ensure that children and staff are as comfortable and safe as possible during the anticipated heat wave next week. The main risk to children is dehydration.

To help, we are doing the following:

- wear sensible, loose-fitting clothing e.g. shorts, t-shirts
- bring hat, suncream
- water: drinking plenty of water regularly through the day
- no PE lessons or running outside at break/lunch if over 30°C
- seek shade during break/lunch times
- rooms: air circulation/fans where possible, relocate to different space if needed
- blinds/shades: to cut down direct heat from sun
- Regular breaks to cool down

Staff have been briefed on the signs and symptoms of heat stress, heat exhaustion and heat stroke. We will be vigilant in looking out for these signs and symptoms and act quickly. **We will update you if Government Advice changes.**

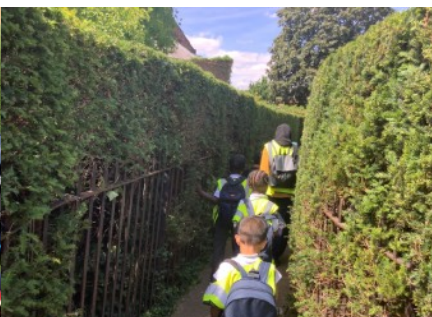
- Please ensure you have booked at least one week in advance - we are not able to accept last-minute bookings.

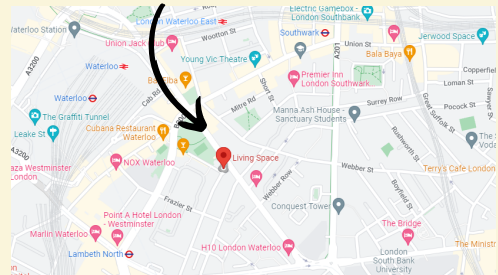

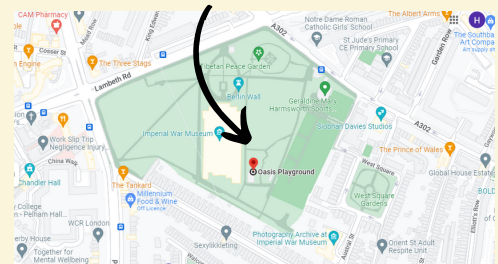

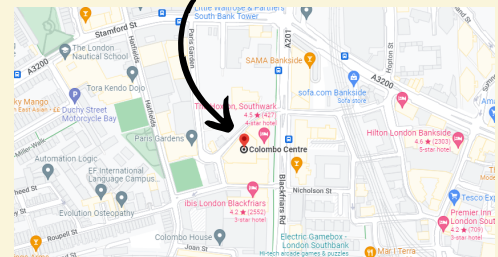
