We will be recognising numerals and linking them to amounts, and identifying which numbers are more or less.



Expressive Art and Design

We will be learning to:

- Develop stories using role play and small world equipment.
- Paint portraits of characters from the story using paintbrushes, fingers and other tools

Please continue to read a story every day with your child, ask them to join in if there are repeated words, phrases or rhymes in the story, or guess what might happen next.

Help your child to be independent by asking them to do little jobs for you and themselves for example getting their shoes and putting them on, or helping unload shopping
