Communication and Language

Children will be learning to develop their vocabulary and speaking skills. They will also be using new vocabulary in full and complex sentences. They will be learning how to follow

more complex instructions and will be listening in groups and as a whole class for longer periods.



Physica Development

We will be learning to: How to use tools to build and different purposes. We will be learning new skills for sports day events. We will go for a local walk. We will continue developing our fine motor skills.



Our topics for this term are Transport, Buildings & Construction and Summer.



Personal, Social, Emotional Development

We will be learning to listen more carefully towards others, especially as there are many class assemblies this term.

The children will be exploring how to be safe in school, at home and outside with their families. Our habits are being **Humble** and **Honest.**



Literacy

We will be learning to: Try to name and label parts of vehicles. We will learn initial sound like "sssss is for snake and Sara."



We will know that when we read and write we start from the left and move to the right. We may even recognise some words around us like names.

Understanding the World

We will be learning about vehicles past and present. We will also learn about how buildings are designed and constructed, and we will be learning about the

changes from Spring to Summer.



Maths

This term we will be consolidating on our number knowledge to 5 and above. We will be learning about sequencing events and days and months. We will learn some positional language.
