Theme - Our topic for this term

Communication and Language

Children will be encouraged to take turns to speak and each other. We will try our best to listen carefully to each other and wait our turn.

We will be also try to answer questions when we are spoken to.



Personal, Social, Emotional Development

We will focus on selecting activities and staying at an activity for a short period of time.

Children will be encouraged to ask for help from adults when they need it.

We will meet other adults around school and learn to be more confident speaking to others.



Physical Development

We will be developing the children's movement skills; running, skipping, hopping and travelling in different ways in PE and in our outdoor space.

Children will be encouraged to be more

independent when dressing and putting on their jumpers and coats independently.



Literacy

Children will be encouraged to learn and recite well known nursery rhymes.

We will be sharing stories and asking and answering questions about stories.

We will experiment with writing and mark making.



Understanding the World

We will be learning about who is in our family and saying how they help us. They will make connections between the features of their family and other families.



Expressive Art and Design

Children will have fun playing in the role play area being 'mums and dads' and shop keepers.

We will join in with songs and rhymes and make sounds

Children will explore different ideas through painting and making.



Maths

We will be focusing on learning a variety of number songs and counting aloud.



We will also be learning our colours and will be matching and sorting various objects.

Homework


Please read a story everyday with your child. Encourage them to talk about what they have read with you. They can use the pictures to tell you what is happening in then story.

Please help to make sure your child is prepared for school and able to use the toilet and out on their coats and jumpers. If they need support then let us know and we will help in any way we can. Thank you.


