





Theme

This term in Yellow Class our theme is 'Citizenship and the World'. The theme will be consistent across our lessons this term





PSHE

In PSHE this term, our unit is 'British Values'. We will explore the 5 areas of British Values, gain an understanding of democracy and what the rule of law is. In addition, individual liberty will be explored and there will be a focus on mutual respect and tolerance.





English

In English this half term, we will continue to read a range of fiction and non-fiction texts. The children will continue to have the opportunity to engage, empathise, explore themes, and develop and sustain ideas through discussion. The children will continue to compose sentences orally and demarcate them accurately. They will gain an understanding of fluency, and develop positive attitudes and stamina for writing. The children will still be expected and encouraged to use conjunctions in their writing, such as because, however and so to extend their sentences. Additionally the children will be identifying verbs, adverbs and compound words and further, learn how to use these in their own writing.



Maths

In Maths this half term, we will cover three core units. The first unit is 'Addition and Subtraction' where we will be continuing to learn our addition and subtraction bonds to 20, and working to understand the relationship between addition and subtraction. The second unit is 'Money', where children will learn to recognise coins and notes and be able to count money - both pence and pounds. The third unit is 'Multiplication and Division', where we will begin to make and add equal groups.



History

This term in History, our unit title is 'Inventions and ideas from around the world: Victorian railways'. We will be learning about Queen Victoria, understanding the growth of the British railway system and in addition, develop our understanding of the growth of railway in India during the Victorian period.



Geography

This term in Geography, the children will be developing their knowledge on the equator and the north and south pole, and how these link to how hot or cold places in the world are. In addition, we will be focusing on famous landmarks both in the UK and our class Oasis global country (India) and look at similarities and differences



Science

This term in Science, we will be focusing on 'Being green'. The children will learn about what climate change is and begin to understand the impact global warming is having on the planet. In addition, we will be looking at recycling, renewable energy and water conservation and how these things can help reduce the impact of global warming.



Art

This term in Art, our focus will be on 'Seascapes - watercolours'. The children will be introduced to the work of JMW Turner who is famous for his British landscape and seascape paintings. They will experiment with watercolour techniques, and learn to mix and tint.



R.E.

This term the children will be looking at the the 'Big Question' - Do we have choices? In addition, they will be continuing their learning on Judaism, focusing on Jewish leaders and teachers who have helped shape Judaism.

P.E.

This term the children will be focusing on stability and locomotion. They will explore transitioning between different balances and explore moving at different speeds. In addition, they will focus on object control, where they will explore some of the basics of racket control.
