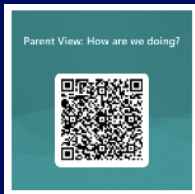

Mini SLT

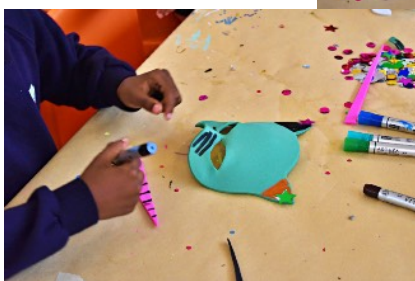
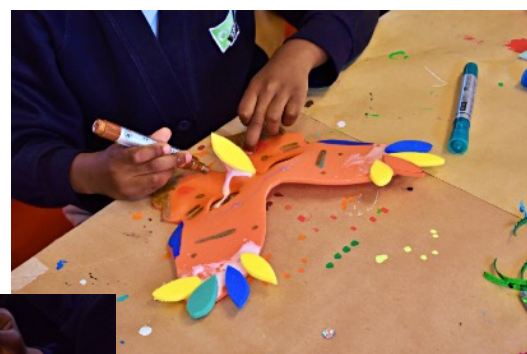
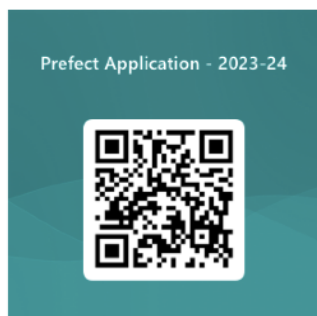
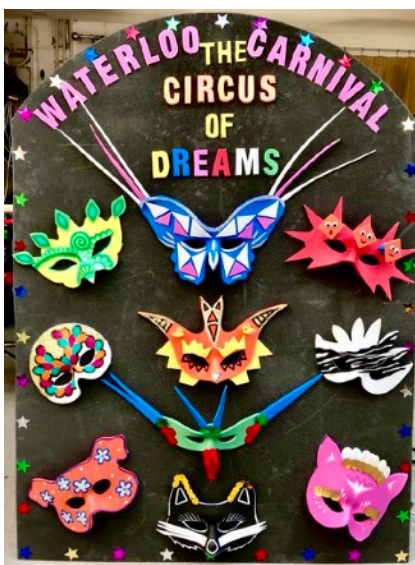
