Absence Reporting

Parents must report any absence by **9am** each morning by telephone. Every day a child is absent, you have to ring in and confirm the reason for their continued absence.

Please **ONLY** book doctors/dental appointments **AFTER** school time to avoid disrupting your child's learning.

8.55am gates close

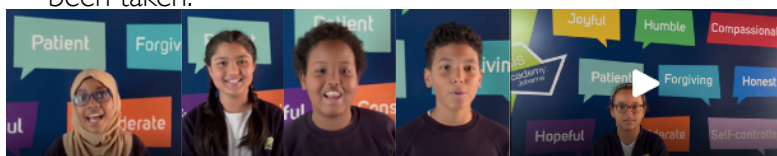
Our gate closes at **8.55am**. This ensures that children have time to store their coat/bag, have a quick drink or visit the toilet, get out and log on to their iPad, and be seated in their chair ready for the register at 9am. This is why our gates close 5 minutes earlier than the register:



Please help your child make a good start to their day by arriving before 8.55am. Children arriving after 8.55am might not make it to class for the register and so are given a slip so their teacher knows that the office are aware they are in school, just in case the register has already been taken.

Mini SLT

Our MINI-SLT were videoed earlier this week speaking about the Oasis 9 Habits and how they helped. Staff from across all of Oasis Community Learning will see the video, along with Mini-SLT members from other primary academies, in our INSET next Friday. We coached them on video technique but there was no need to help them with what to say - we were blown away by how clearly they spoke of how the 9 habits help them in friendships, in work and in preparing them for life beyond school.



Wrapz

Our own after school provision **runs from 3.30pm to 5.50pm**. All children need to be collected promptly. If children are late collected, we will begin to make late charges of £5 per 15 minutes (or part thereof) late. You will receive 2 warnings, but the third instance of late collection will result in a charge.

Parents/carers can collect at **5pm** or **5.50pm**.

We are looking at having an additional collection time of 5.30pm. Please email info@oasisjohanna.org if this would be of interest to you. So far we have only had 1 expression of interest in this, and therefore it is not viable.

Breakfast for all TRIAL

We are getting closer to being able to launch a trial of 'Breakfast for all' where all children are able to come to school a little earlier and get a healthy breakfast each day. Thank you for everyone's patience whilst we have worked hard behind the scenes to get things set up.

Our aim is to start the 'Breakfast for all' on **Monday 31st October at 8.30am for a 2-week trial**. Children will need to arrive promptly at 8.30am so that they have time to sit and eat cereal or a warm, buttered bagel.

The cereal and bagels are provided by Magic Breakfast charity, and they also do this for our wrap-around breakfast club to ensure parity.

What are Online Hate Crimes?

A hate crime describes an incident or crime that takes place against someone based on a part of their identity e.g. their race, ethnicity or religion. Online Hate Speech is viewed very seriously by the Police and those who post hate crime can be charged, which may lead to a criminal record and potentially a prison sentence.

What can I do?
