Polio is spreading in London



Is your child protected against polio?

Polio is a serious virus that can cause paralysis or even death.

Vaccination is the only protection.

There is no cure for polio.

Polio

Polio is an infection caused by a virus that attacks the nervous system - it can cause permanent paralysis of muscles. Before the polio vaccine was introduced, there were as many as 8,000 cases of polio in the UK in epidemic years. There have been no cases of natural polio infection in the UK for 30 due to the success of the polio vaccination programme.

There have been no cases of wild polio (the term used to describe the typical type of polio infection that occurs across the world in unvaccinated communities. However, since February 2022, there have been traces of poliovirus found in sewage samples in North and East London. The polio virus found in London should not pose any risk to those who are fully vaccinated. However, there is a small chance that those who have not been fully vaccinated, or those who cannot respond well to vaccines, could be at risk of catching polio. It is important that children are vaccinated against polio, so they are protected and to reduce the risk of the virus continuing to spread. Please come forward as soon as your child is invited.
