From September 2023, the government have said that all schools must open for 32.5 hours minimum each week. This includes registering the children. Talking with staff and a representative group of parents, we do not need to change our times but ensure that school starts promptly at 8.45am. Most children do come at this time and so is not a change for the vast majority of families. The gate and door times will not change: gate 8.40am and doors 8.45am. Teachers will take the register by 8.50am each morning, so children must come to school by 8.45am and get themselves settled quickly to work.
