### NEU Teacher Strikes

As you may be aware, the National Education Union has formally announced strikes as part of industrial action against the Government around pay, school funding and the recruitment and retention of teachers to the profession. Whilst this is a very emotive issue for many, we hope that everyone in the OAJ community will remain polite, respectful and show the 9 habits in action during the upcoming strikes, particularly compassion, humility and patience.

Due to the number of teachers likely to be on strike, we are only opening to Year 6 and a few invited children. We are not able to provide key worker provision. We are sorry that the strikes will have a significant impact on school opening for our pupils, however teachers hope that parents and carers will fully support their reasons for striking.

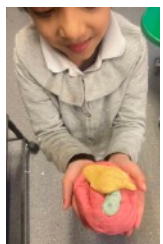


## Extended Day for all

We have a great breakfast and after school extended day provision. For a small charge, children from Nursery to Year 6 can stay in school and receive high quality care, exercise, food, creative activities and much more!

Nursery children can use their 15 and 30 hours funding towards the cost of this provision. For example, nursery children can come to school for 2 full days (7,30am to 3.15pm) using the 15 hours funding, rather than 5 mornings or 5 afternoons.

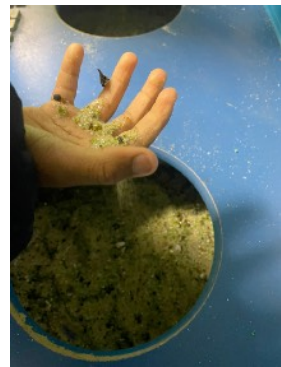
## Y6 Chislehurst Caves
