on them. You will be able to see how they got on via Showbie, in the Spelling folder on their iPad.



Maths

We will begin the year by deepening our understanding of the Place Value of integers (or whole numbers) up to a million. We will also be consolidating and building on our



arithmetic skills and making sure our times tables are really well learnt. It is very important that every child arrives with a fully charged iPad every day for these lessons. So far, Indigo Class are doing well with this responsibility.

Three mornings every week we will start the day by practising our times tables on Time Table Rock Stars. Other apps to help support fast recall of times tables facts at home are 'Hit the Button' and 'Sumdog'.





Science

We begin our year with the study of the life cycle of plants and animals including mammals, birds, insects and amphibians. We will compare and contrast these life cycles and learn the scientific vocabulary to explain them. We will use observation and investigation to find out about the parts of a flowering plant and how they reproduce.

R.E.

Throughout the year, in RE, Indigo Class will be learning about Sikhism. This term we will find out about Sikh beliefs and history.



P.E.

In P.E., Louise will teach us how to improve our fitness as well as taking part in invasion games to improve our skills for object control. PE days are Wednesday and Friday, when children can come to school in their PE kit.

Homework

In Indigo Class, weekly homework is:

- Reading a book for 10 minutes each day. Your child then records this <u>themselves</u> with a comment about what they read in their reading record.
- Practise spellings on Ed Shed twice a week in preparation for the weekly **test on Friday.**
- Completing Sumdog or Times Tables Rockstar tasks set by the teacher, on their iPad, at least twice a week.
- Completing a menu task in their homework book and handing this in each **Monday.**
