Unicorn Theatre Partnership

You might have noticed there have been lots of trips this year to the Unicorn Theatre in London Bridge.

Let me tell you why....

Oasis Academy Johanna have entered into a 3 year creative partnership with the Unicorn



Theatre. This was an opportunity that we initially applied for, was shortlisted for and then we were specially chosen for!

What is the Unicorn Theatre all about?

It is the largest children's theatre in the UK and it specialises in developing new shows as well as adapting classic texts.

What does the theatre gain from this partnership?

As the theatre develops new productions, Johanna children become their 'Creative Consultants'. Hearing the voices of children as new shows are developed guarantees that the voices of young people are heard on stage and that the work of the theatre remains relevant to their young audiences.

What does Johanna gain from this partnership?

There are 3 projects across the year, each project will last one half term, during which a class will work with Unicorn staff to develop a new production. On top of this, there are lots of free tickets for Johanna children to go to the theatre and a free technical workshop for year 6 in the summer term. The other big win for Johanna is that we receive professional training on using drama techniques in the classroom which will be both fun and beneficial to staff and children.

This is the first year of the partnership and it has been a great success. We are very excited to continue working alongside creative professionals as we help each other to learn and develop.

Look out for more involvement from the Unicorn Theatre; we already some tickets booked for January 2025!
