As you are aware from the end of last year we have made some changes to the start of the day routine.

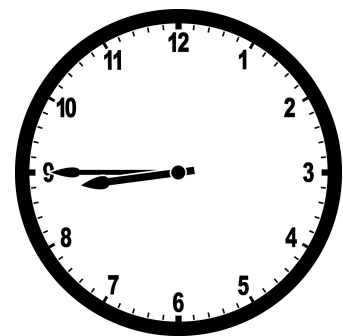
At 8.40 the main gate on Frazier St opens for all pupils.
