Attendance and Punctuality

Overall attendance in the last week was 95%. Blue class were the highest class with an impressive 99.6%.

As mentioned earlier, we were notified this week that we were in the top 10% of similar schools nationally for attendance in the spring term. This is a great achievement.

Next year, as part of a national drive for attendance, the target for all pupils is raised to 97%. This has been chosen as this is the point where children start to get worse results in schools when they drop below this level. Realistically this means missing about 5 days of school per year. Please ensure that holidays are booked outside term time and appointments are made in the holidays and weekends where possible.

Punctuality also remains a key concern of the school. **School starts at 8.45** and this will stay the same next academic year.
