If your child is absent for any other reason that is not medically related, please notify the school office and come in and pick up a term time absence form.

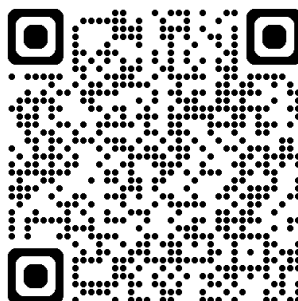
This will need to be signed off by the principal or assistant principal.

Some beautiful fruit kebabs from reception this week.

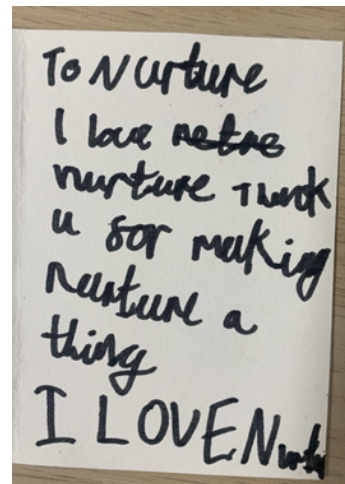
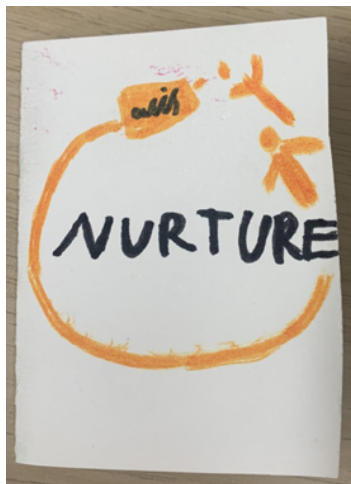
