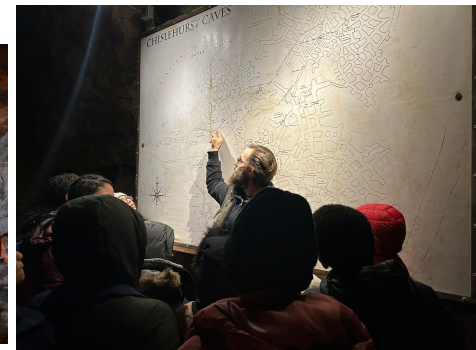




## Year 6 Trips to Chislehurst and the Imperial War Museum

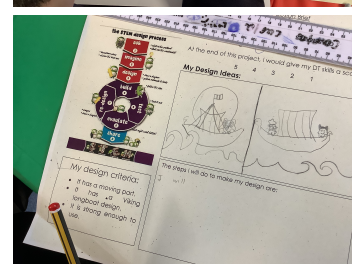
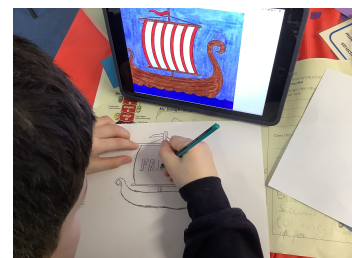
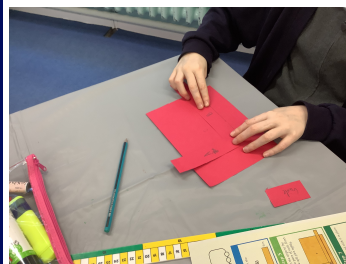


## Year 5 Design and Technology Day

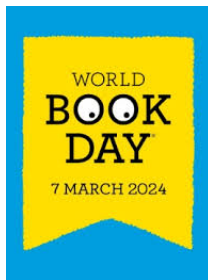


# World Book Day 2024
