A rare four page newsletter as we get close to the end of term. So much important news that two pages simply isn't enough.

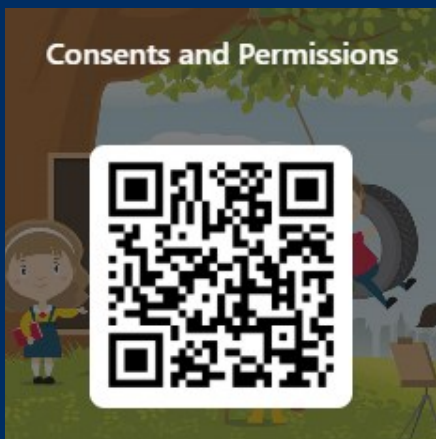

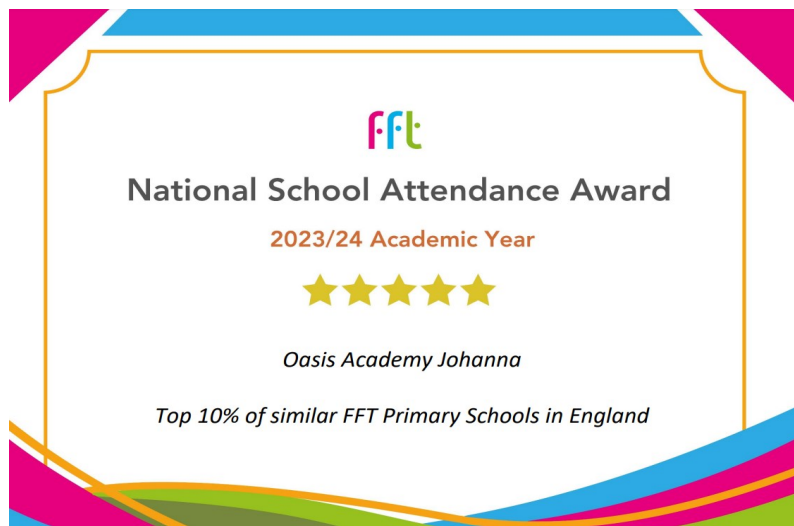
Attendance
