Consultation on School Name Change

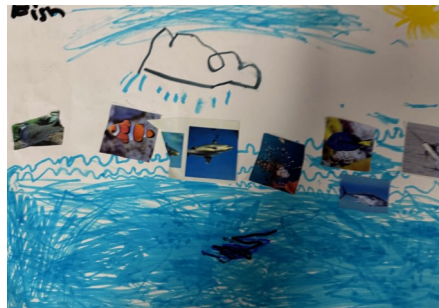

The schools would remain separate with their own leadership and individual in school identities but would align in branding. This would be designed to more clearly show the learning journey at Oasis from Nursery to Sixth Form.
